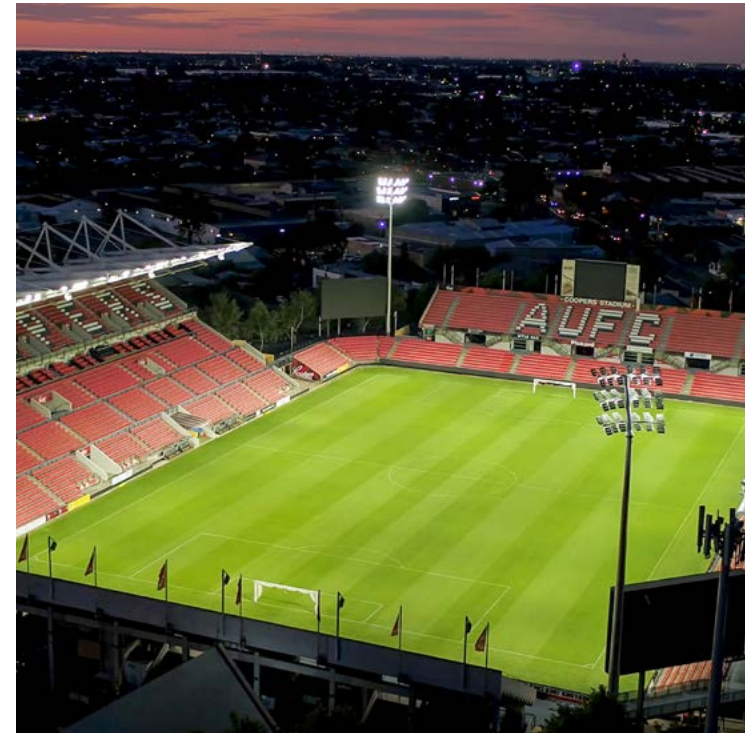

This starts at \$34.64 per hour at entry level before moving to \$36.15 per hour after only 50 hours of work with us, plus an additional 11% employer superannuation.

With events ranging from breakfast seminars through to night-time concerts and sporting matches, we're always on the lookout for applicants who have flexibility to work a variety of different shifts. We find this variety suits the student lifestyle, enabling students to effortlessly balance work and study commitments.

While previous experience in the events industry isn't essential—we offer paid on-the-job training so you can learn while still being rewarded—a 'can do' attitude is crucial, as is a willingness to learn key roles across a variety of different work areas, from food and beverage to customer service standards and back of house practices, just to name a few.
